Teacher Ambassadors will work with AgScape staff to develop a local network of schools and events in which to deliver lessons and presentations using AgScape materials.

 - currently in a Bachelor of Education/Master of Teaching program, as recognized by the Ontario College of Teachers
 - o currently in an Early Childhood Education Program
 - registered as an Early Childhood Educator
- Must have access to a vehicle or public transportation
- Must have access to reliable internet and computer
- Comfortable with working with technology (i.e. educational technologies, a variety of web conferencing software, Google Workspace etc.)
- Possess strong interpersonal and leadership skills
- Have the ability to take initiative and self-manage
- Communicate effectively through a variety of oral, written and digital forms
